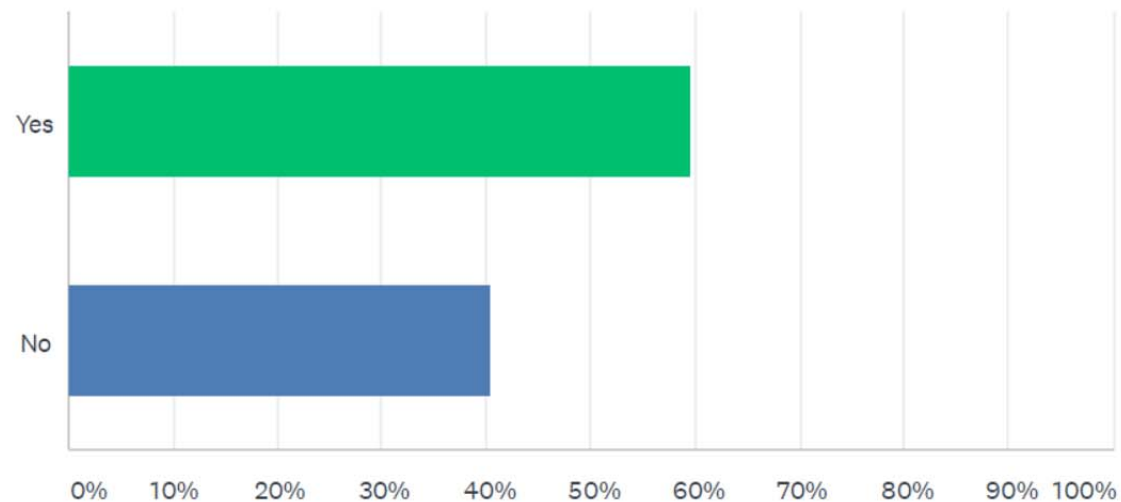


Jefferson County COVID-19 Business Re-Opening Survey Report

The Port Townsend Main Street Program, the Chamber of Jefferson County, and Team Jefferson/EDC collaborated on sending a survey to their constituents to ask them to weigh in on reopening businesses in Jefferson County, what resources they need, and their concerns.

The survey was completed by 283 people from Wednesday, May 13th through Friday May 15, 2020. The survey was sent to the Port Townsend Main Street Business list, and the Chamber of Jefferson County and EDC Team Jefferson distribution lists.

Q1: As a business owner in Jefferson County, do you want the Board of Health to apply for variance to allow Jefferson County to advance into Phase 2 now?
